The Project

- Joint project
- 2 years
 - May 04 - Apr 06



The Plan

- Newcastle and Durham share medical students
- Authorise these students and staff using Shibboleth
 - access from both universities *and* the NHS
- Staged approach - develop, disseminate

Objective

More people using Shibboleth

- Documentation for two levels
 - informing management
 - ‘recipes’ for setting up origins and targets
- Interfaces with two VLEs
 - BlackBoard (commercial)
 - Zope (open source)

Progress

- Pubcookie servers
- Several Shibboleth origin servers
 - Durham used docs to set up origin (*and KC-ROLO*)
- Joined several federations (SDSS and Athens)
- Access to online journals (*demo later*)
- Various Dissemination events
 - librarians, medical IT, NHS-HE connectivity

Now

- Zope and BlackBoard targets
- Scoping legal documents
- More documentation (in under a month)
 - joining federations
 - accessing electronic journals using Shibboleth
 - attribute identification and storage

Lessons learnt

- Certification authorities and federations
- Joining more than one federation can be problematic (*especially if they're using different CA's*)
- Active Directory Issues
- Technical authors are hard to find...

What's next?

- Test service for Newcastle VLE
 - small number of staff from Durham, Newcastle and the NHS
- Document
 - Blackboard as a Shibboleth target
 - Lessons learnt from setting up VLE service
 - Attribute aggregation
